

Shipments prohibited for transfer for delivery and/or storage.

Prohibited Shipments: any items and substances that during sending (or storage) are capable of detonating, reacting dangerously, igniting, causing elevated temperature or releasing toxic, corrosive or combustible gas, or vapors that must not be transported under standard transportation conditions under any circumstances.

Hazardous Shipments* (1-8 danger class): these are items and substances capable of threatening health, safety, property or the environment. The list was cited in the List of Hazardous Shipments in "Dangerous Goods Regulations" IATA/"Technical Instructions for Safe Transport of Dangerous Cargoes by Air" ICAO/ADR "International Agreement concerning the Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road", or classified in accordance with this Appendix to the Regulation.

Special Shipments (Shipments of special categories): these are Shipments that require observing special conditions for their transport and processing (live animals, perishable shipments, hunting trophies, valuable shipments, weapons and military equipment, sports weapons, live human organs, human remains).

Shipments of uncertain nature: determination/confirmation of the properties and characteristics is impossible.

Classification of deliveries prohibited for transfer and/or storage of Shipments

Classification/description	Items and substances (examples)
<u>CLASS 1</u> Explosive substances	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - all kinds of gunpowder, in any package and in any quantity; - live round/for gas weapons; hunting primers (caps); - pyrotechnic devices: signal and lighting flares, signal caps, landing charges, smoke cartridges (charges), demolition matches, Bengal fires, railroad detonators; trotyl, dynamite, tolit, ammonal and other explosive substances, primers, detonators, electric detonators, electric igniters, detonating and fuses, etc.
<u>CLASS 2</u> Gases	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - household gases (butane-propane) and other gases; - cylinders filled with nerve and tear gas; - pressurized cylinders, aerosol cylinders (not classified as perfume products); - gas shock absorbers.
<u>CLASS 3</u> Flammable liquids	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - alcohols, esters, acetone, gasoline, kerosene; - paint, lacquer, glue, polish, putty, enamel (based on organic solvents); - ink, printer's ink; - samples of flammable petroleum products.
<u>CLASS 4</u> Flammable solids	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - substances liable to self combustion; - substances releasing flammable gases during interaction with water; - matches, sulfur, nitronaphthalene celluloid; - with or yellow phosphorous, magnesium diamide; - calcium carbide, sodium, potassium, etc.
<u>CLASS 5</u> Oxidizers and organic peroxides	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - ammonia-nitrate fertilizers, ammonium nitrate, potassium nitrate; - calcium chlorate, hydrogen peroxide, tertiary-butyl hydroperoxide; - bleaches, etc.
<u>CLASS 6</u> Toxic and infectious substances	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - any toxic, potent and poisonous substances in liquid or solid state, packed in any container: pesticides, brucine, nicotine, strychnine, mercury, etc.; - all cyanides and cyanide preparations, cyanide-impregnated absorbent, arsenic, etc.; - samples of biological materials, viruses, clinical waste, etc.
<u>CLASS 7</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - medical or industrial radionuclides or isotopes such as Cobalt 60, Cesium-131,

Radioactive material	<p>Iodine 132;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - nuclear material: Uranium 233 and 235, Plutonium 239 and 241; - medical drugs and equipment with radioactive components, radioactive material waste.
<u>CLASS 8</u> Corrosive substances	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - acids (hydrochloric, sulfuric, nitric, etc.); - alkalis (sodium hydroxide, potassium hydroxide, etc.); - alkaline, acid storage batteries and batteries.
<u>Rubber tires</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - This ban is in force in Moscow, Moscow Oblast, Krasnodar and Krasnodar Krai. Shipments to other regions are possible only with the use of additional order type — “Tires”. This ban extends to all types of tires: for vehicles, bikes, bicycles, and others that contain rubber.
Firearms, gas, pneumatic, cold weapons of all types	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - pistols, revolvers, rifles, carbines and other firearms, gas, pneumatic weapons; - primary parts of firearms: barrel, slide, barrel, body, breech; - electric shock devices and their simulators; - crossbows, weapons for underwater hunting, charges, sabers, hatchets, yataghans, broadswords, swords, bayonets, daggers, dirks, stilettos, knives. <p><i>Note: Weapons do not include items certified as household and production items, sports equipment that are similar in design to weapons.</i></p>
Narcotics and psychotropic substances	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - narcotics, psychotropic substances and their precursors subject to control in the Territory and included in the list of relevant authorities.
Precious and rare earth metals, precious stones and items made of them	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - gold bars and coins, gold in the form of grains, sheets, sand, foil, wire, etc.; - platinum, metals in the platinum group (palladium, iridium, ruthenium, osmium and rhodium); - diamonds (including diamonds for industrial use), rubies, emeralds, sapphires, opals and natural pearl; - jewelery items and watches
Cash and cash equivalents	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - bank notes in circulation, road (tourist) checks, securities, stocks, coupons of stocks and stamps, bank and credit cards ready for use.
Live animals, hunting trophies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - live animals, animal organs, animal remains; - fur raw material, undressed pelts, skins; - hunting trophies.
Perishable food products	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - dairy, meat and fish products, vegetables and fruits, baked goods.
Human remains	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - human remains (coffins, urns).

The following articles are also banned for international delivery from/to/through the EAEU's territory:

1. Alcoholic beverages and beer, with the exception of alcoholic beverages and beer in the volumes within 5 liters inclusively delivered in a single international Shipment.

during their export from the EAEU's customs territory, provided that the senders have authorization documents for the production and/or turnover of such products (goods);

delivered as specimens and samples for research or testing, provided that the senders and/or receivers have authorization documents for the production and/or turnover (including import and export) of such products (goods), a contract with the accredited certification agency or a letter from such accredited certification agency confirming the quantity (weight and volume) of such products (goods) that is needed for such purposes;

delivered to the accredited certification agency as specimens and samples for measuring pursuant to international standards; for research, experiments or testing, provided that a letter from such accredited certification agency is available to confirm the quantity (weight and volume) of such products (goods) that is needed for such purposes;

delivered to an individual during import into the EAEU's customs territory or from an individual during export from the EAEU's customs territory;

not delivered to the intended addressees and returned to the senders mentioned in this clause (shipment returns).

2. Ethyl alcohol, with the exception of ethyl alcohol in the volumes within 5 liters inclusively delivered in a single international Shipment:

delivered as specimens and samples for research or testing, provided that the senders and/or receivers have authorization documents for the production and/or turnover (including import and export) of ethyl alcohol, a contract with the accredited certification agency or a letter from such accredited certification agency confirming the quantity (weight and volume) of ethyl alcohol that is needed for such purposes;

delivered to the accredited certification agency as specimens and samples for measuring pursuant to international standards; for research, experiments or testing, provided that a letter from such accredited certification agency is available to confirm the quantity (weight and volume) of ethyl alcohol that is needed for such purposes;

delivered to an individual during import into the EAEU's customs territory or from an individual during export from the EAEU's customs territory;

not delivered to the intended addressees and returned to the senders mentioned in this clause (shipment returns).

3. Tobacco products, smoking blends, tobacco-free smoking products and other nicotine-containing products, non-smoking tobacco products (chewing tobacco, snuffing tobacco, snus, snuff, naswar, etc.), electronic delivery systems (vapes), both reusable and disposable, flavorings, flavouring liquids, with the exception of those:

delivered as specimens and samples for research or testing, provided that the senders and/or receivers have authorization documents for the production and/or turnover (including import and export) of such products (goods), a contract with the accredited certification agency or a letter from such accredited certification agency confirming the quantity (weight and volume) of such products (goods) that is needed for such purposes;

delivered to the accredited certification agency as specimens and samples for measuring pursuant to international standards; for research, experiments or testing, provided that a letter from such accredited certification agency is available to confirm the quantity (weight and volume) of such products (goods) that is needed for such purposes;

not delivered to the intended addressees and returned to the senders mentioned in this clause (shipment returns);

4. Delivered to the Republic of Kazakhstan or transiting through its territory without a transit customs declaration:

tobacco products, smoking blends without means of identification pursuant to the laws of Kazakhstan,

tobacco-free smoking products and other nicotine-containing products, non-smoking tobacco products (chewing tobacco, snuffing tobacco, snus, snuff, naswar, etc.), electronic delivery systems (vapes), both reusable and disposable, flavorings, flavouring liquids.

5. Trinitrotoluenes and dinitronaphthalenes.

6. Potentially pathogenic and pathogenic genetically engineered organisms (genetically modified microorganisms (bacteria, viruses, chlamydiae, rickettsia, protozoans, fungi, mycoplasmas) or genetic components (fragments) containing nucleic acid sequences (sections), pathogenicity coding factors, and

genetically modified microorganisms or genetic components (fragments) obtained from microorganisms containing nucleic acid sequences (sections) that code any of the toxins).

7. Smoke powder, pyroxyline powder, ballistite powder and solid rocket fuels, granipores.
8. Ready-made explosive substances, except powders (including grammonites, ammonites, TNT charges, gelexes, granulotol, aluminotol, plastic explosives, spark arresters).
9. Match cords, detonating cords, percussion or blasting caps, priming charges, electric detonators, other non-electric initiating systems.
10. Fireworks, signal flares, anti-hail rockets, anti-fog rockets and other pyrotechnics.
11. Articles from the list of items banned for import into the customs territory of the Eurasian Economic Union and/or export from the customs territory of the Eurasian Economic Union (Appendix No. 1 to the Decision of the Board of the Eurasian Economic Commission dated April 21, 2015 No. 30).
12. Articles listed in sections 2.1 (ozone depleting substances), 2.3 (hazardous waste) and 2.13 (toxic substances except for precursors of drugs and psychotropic substances) of the list of goods subject to the permissive procedure for import/export into/from the EAEU's customs territory (Appendix No. 2 to the Decision of the Board of the Eurasian Economic Commission dated April 21, 2015 No. 30 — The inventory).
13. Natural diamonds listed in table 1, section 2.9 of the Inventory, and precious stones listed in paragraphs 1-6, table 2, section 2.9 of the Inventory.
14. Precious metals and raw materials containing precious metals listed in tables 1 and 2, section 2.10 of the Inventory.
15. Articles listed in section 2.12 (drugs, psychotropic substances and their precursors) of the Inventory.
16. Articles containing drugs, psychotropic substances and their precursors - mimosa hostilis (Mimosa tenuiflora plant species), poisonous plants.
17. Articles listed in section 2.21 (human organs and tissues, blood and its components, human biological specimens) of the Inventory that are conveyed for personal use (with the exception of human biological specimens).
18. Weapons (their parts), weapon cartridges (their parts), articles similar in design to weapons, with the exception of general-use articles similar in design to weapons.
19. Articles listed in sections 2.2 (plant protection agents (pesticides)) and 2.17 (special technical devices to surreptitiously obtain information) of the Inventory that are imported into the EAEU's customs territory for personal use.
20. Articles listed in sections 2.11 (crude minerals), 2.17 (special technical devices to surreptitiously obtain information), 2.20 (cultural values, documents from national archives, original archive documents) and 2.23 (information about subsurface resources for specific regions and fields of fuel, energy and mineral stock) of the Inventory that are exported from the EAEU's customs territory for personal use.
21. Articles listed in section 2.30 (plant protection agents and other stable organic contaminants for use in laboratory research, and as a reference standard) of the Inventory that are imported into the EAEU's customs territory.
