

Shipments prohibited for transfer to the courier service for delivery and/or storage.

Prohibited Shipments: any items and substances that during sending (or storage) are capable of detonating, reacting dangerously, igniting, causing elevated temperature or releasing toxic, corrosive or combustible gas, or vapors that must not be transported under standard transportation conditions under any circumstances.

Hazardous Shipments* (1-8 danger class): these are items and substances capable of threatening health, safety, property or the environment. The list was cited in the List of Hazardous Shipments in "Dangerous Goods Regulations" IATA/"Technical Instructions for Safe Transport of Dangerous Cargoes by Air" ICAO/ADR "International Agreement concerning the Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road", or classified in accordance with this Appendix to the Regulation.

Special Shipments (Shipments of special categories): these are Shipments that require observing special conditions for their transport and processing (live animals, perishable shipments, hunting trophies, valuable shipments, weapons and military equipment, sports weapons, live human organs, human remains).

Shipments of uncertain nature: determination/confirmation of the properties and characteristics is impossible.

Classification of deliveries prohibited for transfer and/or storage of Shipments

Classification/description	Items and substances (examples)
CLASS 1 Explosive substances	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - all kinds of gunpowder, in any package and in any quantity; - live round/for gas weapons; hunting primers (caps); - pyrotechnic devices: signal and lighting flares, signal caps, landing charges, smoke cartridges (charges), demolition matches, Bengal fires, railroad detonators; trotyl, dynamite, tolit, ammonal and other explosive substances, primers, detonators, electric detonators, electric igniters, detonating and fuses, etc.
CLASS 2 Gases	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - household gases (butane-propane) and other gases; - cylinders filled with nerve and tear gas; - pressurized cylinders, aerosol cylinders (not classified as perfume products); - gas shock absorbers.
CLASS 3 Flammable liquids	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - alcohols, esters, acetone, gasoline, kerosene; - paint, lacquer, glue, polish, putty, enamel (based on organic solvents); - ink, printer's ink; - samples of flammable petroleum products.
CLASS 4 Flammable solids	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - substances liable to self combustion; - substances releasing flammable gases during interaction with water; - matches, sulfur, nitronaphthalene celluloid; - with or yellow phosphorous, magnesium diamide; - calcium carbide, sodium, potassium, etc.
CLASS 5 Oxidizers and organic peroxides	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - ammonia-nitrate fertilizers, ammonium nitrate, potassium nitrate; - calcium chlorate, hydrogen peroxide, tertiary-butyl hydroperoxide; - bleaches, etc.
CLASS 6 Toxic and infectious substances	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - any toxic, potent and poisonous substances in liquid or solid state, packed in any container: pesticides, brucine, nicotine, strychnine, mercury, etc.; - all cyanides and cyanide preparations, cyanide-impregnated absorbent, arsenic, etc.; - samples of biological materials, viruses, clinical waste, etc.
CLASS 7	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - medical or industrial radionuclides or isotopes such as Cobalt 60, Cesium-131, Iodine 132;

* *****The list may be expanded by contents of any nature under control in the Territory and included in the relevant regulatory legal acts of the local authorities. The Contractor can provide detailed information about such contents.

Radioactive material	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - nuclear material: Uranium 233 and 235, Plutonium 239 and 241; - medical drugs and equipment with radioactive components, radioactive material waste.
CLASS 8 Corrosive substances	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - acids (hydrochloric, sulfuric, nitric, etc.); - alkalis (sodium hydroxide, potassium hydroxide, etc.); - alkaline, acid storage batteries and batteries.
Firearms, gas, pneumatic, cold weapons of all types	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - pistols, revolvers, rifles, carbines and other firearms, gas, pneumatic weapons; - primary parts of firearms: barrel, slide, barrel, body, breech; - electric shock devices and their simulators; - crossbows, weapons for underwater hunting, charges, sabers, hatchets, yataghans, broadswords, swords, bayonets, daggers, dirks, stilettos, knives. <p><i>Note: Weapons do not include items certified as household and production items, sports equipment that are similar in design to weapons.</i></p>
Narcotics and psychotropic substances	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - narcotics, psychotropic substances and their precursors subject to control in the Territory and included in the list of relevant authorities.
Precious and rare earth metals, precious stones and items made of them	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - gold bars and coins, gold in the form of grains, sheets, sand, foil, wire, etc.; - platinum, metals in the platinum group (palladium, iridium, ruthenium, osmium and rhodium); - diamonds (including diamonds for industrial use), rubies, emeralds, sapphires, opals and natural pearl; - jewelery items and watches
Cash and cash equivalents	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - bank notes in circulation, road (tourist) checks, securities, stocks, coupons of stocks and stamps, bank and credit cards ready for use.
Live animals, hunting trophies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - live animals, animal organs, animal remains; - fur raw material, undressed pelts, skins; - hunting trophies.
Perishable food products	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - dairy, meat and fish products, vegetables and fruits, baked goods.
Human remains	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - human remains (coffins, urns).

Also prohibited for international delivery from/to/through EAEU territory:

1. Alcoholic products and beer, with the exception of alcoholic products and beer up to 5 liters inclusively, to be shipped in **one** international Shipment.

with their export from EAEU customs territory if the sender has permit documents for production and/or movement of such products (goods);

as specimens and samples for studies or tests if the sender and/or receiver has permit documents for production and/or movement (including import and export) of such products (goods), contract with accredited certification agency or letter from such accredited certification agency confirming the requisite quantity (weight and volume) of such products (goods) for these purposes;

as specimens and samples to the accredited certification agency for measurements pursuant to international standards, conducting research, experiments or tests if there is a letter from such accredited certification agency confirming the requisite quantity (weight and volume) of such products (goods) for these purposes;

to an individual with import into the EAEU customs territory or from an individual with export from the EAEU customs territory;

in case of return to the senders indicated in this clause not given to the shipment addressee (shipment return).

2. Ethyl alcohol, with the exception of ethyl alcohol up to 5 liters inclusively, to be shipped in one international Shipment:

as specimens and samples for studies or tests if the sender/receiver has permit documents for production and/or movement (including import and export) of ethyl alcohol, contract with accredited

certification agency or letter from such accredited certification agency confirming the requisite quantity (weight and volume) of ethyl alcohol for these purposes;

as specimens and samples to an accredited certification agency for measurements pursuant to international standards, conducting research, experiments or tests if there is a letter from such accredited certification agency confirming the requisite quantity (weight and volume) of ethyl alcohol for these purposes;

to an individual with import into the EAEU customs territory or from an individual with export from the EAEU customs territory;

in case of return to the senders indicated in this clause not given to the shipment addressee (shipment return).

3. Tobacco items, smoking mixtures, tobacco-free smoking items and other nicotine-containing products, non-smoking tobacco items (chewing tobacco, snuff, snus, naswar, etc.), e-systems (vapes), both reusable and disposable, air fresheners, liquids for them, with the exception of:

a) up to 1,000 cigarettes or up to 200 cigars or up to 1,000 grams of tobacco, or up to 1,000 grams total weight of the indicated items or other nicotine-containing products, including liquids for use in nicotine-delivery systems, and fillers for nicotine-delivery systems, including non-nicotine costing under 500 euros, to be sent in one international Shipment:

as specimens and samples for studies or tests if the sender and/or receiver has permit documents for production and/or movement (including import and export) of such products (goods), contract with accredited certification agency or letter from such accredited certification agency confirming the requisite quantity (weight and volume) of such products (goods) for these purposes;

as specimens and samples to the accredited certification agency for measurements pursuant to international standards, conducting research, experiments or tests if there is a letter from such accredited certification agency confirming the requisite quantity (weight and volume) of such products (goods) for these purposes;

in case of return to the senders indicated in this clause not given to the shipment addressee (shipment return);

b) 200 cigarettes or 50 cigars (cigarillos), or 200 items with heatable tobacco ("sticks"), or 250 grams of tobacco, or items in an assortment with total weight under 250 grams to be sent in one international Shipment to an individual with import to the EAEU customs territory or from an individual with export from the EAEU customs territory.

4. To the Republic of Kazakhstan or by transit through the Republic of Kazakhstan territory without transit customs clearance declaration:

tobacco items, smoking mixtures without identification pursuant to Kazakhstan law,

tobacco-free smoking items and other nicotine-containing products, non-smoking tobacco items (chewing tobacco, snuff, snus, naswar, etc.), e-systems (vapes), both reusable and disposable, air fresheners, liquids for them.

5. Trinitrotoluenes and dinitronaphthalenes.

6. Nominally pathogenic and pathogenic genetically engineered organisms (genetically altered microorganisms (bacteria, viruses, Chlamydiae, Rickettsia, Protozoa, fungi, mycoplasmas) or genetic components (fragments) that contain nucleic acid sequences (sections), pathogenicity coding factors and are obtained from microorganisms, genetically altered microorganisms or genetic components (fragments) that contain nucleic acid sequences (sections), coding any of the toxins).

7. Smoke powder, pyropowder, ballistite powder and solid jet fuel, granipores.

8. Ready-made explosives, except powder (including grammonites, ammonites, trotyl charges, gelexes, granulotole, alumotrinitrotoluene, plastic explosives).

9. Fuses, blasting fuses, percussion or blasting caps, primers, electric detonators, other non-electric initiating systems.

10. Fireworks, signal flares, rain flares, anti-fog signals and other pyrotechnic items.

11. Goods indicated in the goods list that are prohibited for import into the Eurasian Economic Union customs territory and/or export from the Eurasian Economic Union customs territory (Appendix No. 1 to Decision No. 30 of the Eurasian Economic Commission Board dated April 21, 2015) - attached.

12. Goods indicated in sections 2.1 (ozone-destroying substances), 2.3 (hazardous wastes) and 2.13 (toxic substances that are not precursors of narcotics and psychotropic substances) of the list of goods with an established permit procedure for import/export to the EAEU customs territory/from the EAEU customs

territory (Appendix No. 2 to Decision No. 30 of the Eurasian Economic Commission Board dated April 21, 2015 - List) - attached.

13. Natural diamonds indicated in Table 1 of section 2.9 of the List, and precious stones indicated in clauses 1 - 6 of Table 2 in section 2.9 of the List.

14. Precious metals and raw material goods containing precious metals indicated in Tables 1 and 2 of section 2.10 of the List.

15. Goods indicated in section 2.12 (narcotics, psychotropic substances and their precursors) of the List.

16. Goods containing narcotics, psychotropic substances and their precursors - mimosa hostilis (plant of the Mimosa tenuiflora species).

17. Goods indicated in section 2.21 (human organs and tissues, blood and its components, samples of human biological materials) of the List to be moved as goods for personal use (with the exception of human biological material samples).

18. Weapons (or parts), shells for them (their parts) that are similar in design to the weapons of the item, with the exception of appliances.

19. Goods indicated in sections 2.2 (plant protection (pesticides)) and 2.17 (special technical tools for secret obtaining of information) of the List to be imported into the EAEU customs territory as goods for personal use.

20. Goods indicated in sections 2.11 (mineral raw materials types), 2.17 (special technical tools for secret obtaining of information), 2.20 (cultural valuables, national archive funds documents, original archive documents) and 2.23 (information about mineral resources for regions and fields of fuel-energy and mineral raw materials) of the List to be exported from the EAEU customs territory as goods for personal use.

21. Goods indicated in section 2.30 (plant protection and other stable organic contaminants for use in laboratory research, as well as for a reference standard) of the List to be imported into the EAEU customs territory.
